Display Deleted Posts

1. From the Course Navbar, select [Collaboration] followed by [Discussions].



2. From the **Discussions** area, select [Settings].



3. Under the **Personal Settings** section, check the box next to **[Display deleted posts]** followed by **[Save]**.

To Restore a Deleted Topic

1. From the Discussion List tab, select [More Actions] followed by [Restore].



NOTE: When you restore a **Forum**, you will be given the option to also restore any topics it contains.

2. Click **[Restore]** under the **Action** column next to the forum or topic you want to restore.
