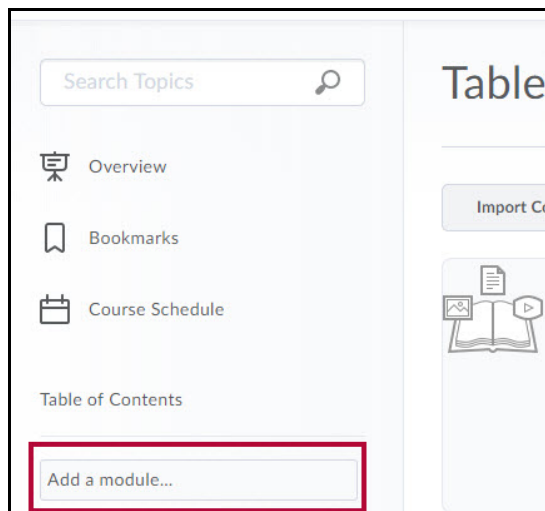
## Getting Your Course Set Up

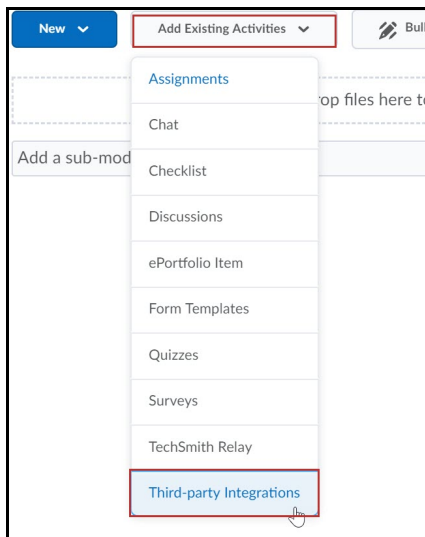
1. Send an email to [VTAC@lonestar.edu](mailto:VTAC@lonestar.edu) ().
2. Include a list of the courses, complete with section numbers and terms, in which you want to use ALEKS.

## Adding the ALEKS integration to Your D2L Course

1. Open your course in D2L.
2. Go to Content and select the module where you want to insert the ALEKS integration (for example, add a module and give it a name such as "ALEKS").



3. In your module, click the **Add Existing Activities** button, and select **Third-party Integrations**.



4. Select **McGraw-Hill Campus Math** or **ALEKS Chemistry/Science** from the list.
  - LSC-Kingwood math courses use **McGraw-Hill Campus Gateway Connect**.
