## Work To Do Widget

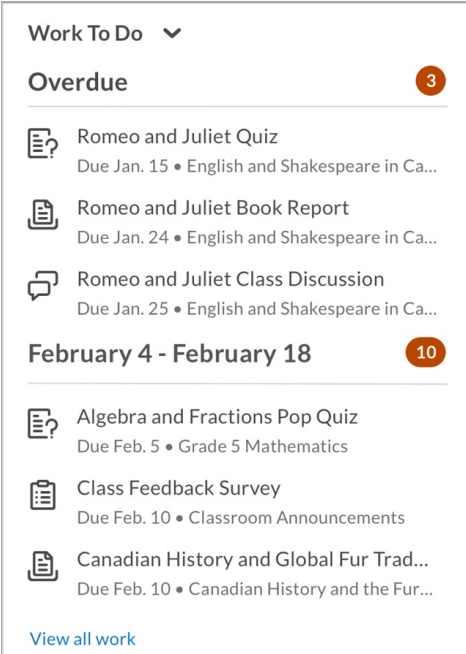
The Work To Do widget provides students a summary of assigned learning activities from all their courses that are overdue or have an upcoming due date.

The Work To Do widget displays the following learning activities:

- Assignments
- Checklists
- Content
- Courses
- Discussions
- Surveys
- Quizzes

**NOTE:** It is not recommended to set **Due Dates** and **End Dates** on Content Modules. If the module has **Due Dates** even if the activities of a module will be completed the module still show as "Overdue" on the "Work-to-do" widget. The "Overdue" will not appear after the End Date. However if the module has a **End Date** the students will not be able to access the module's content after that date.

If a student has activities that are late or due, the widget displays this:
