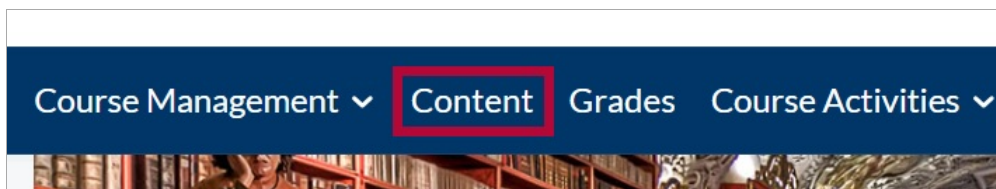

## Add YuJa Video To Content

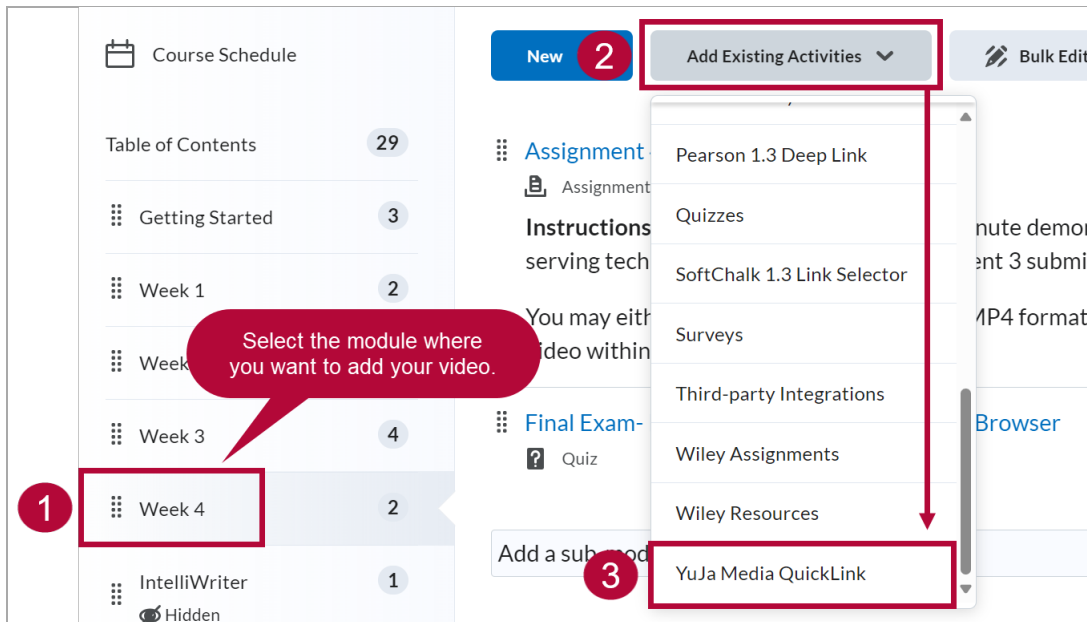
▶ Show Video Walkthrough

**NOTE:** When you are creating an announcement and need to embed a YuJa video, use the **Source Code (HTML Editor)** option, instead of the **[Insert stuff] → [Enter Embed Code]** route.

1. Select **[Content]** on the Course **Navbar**.

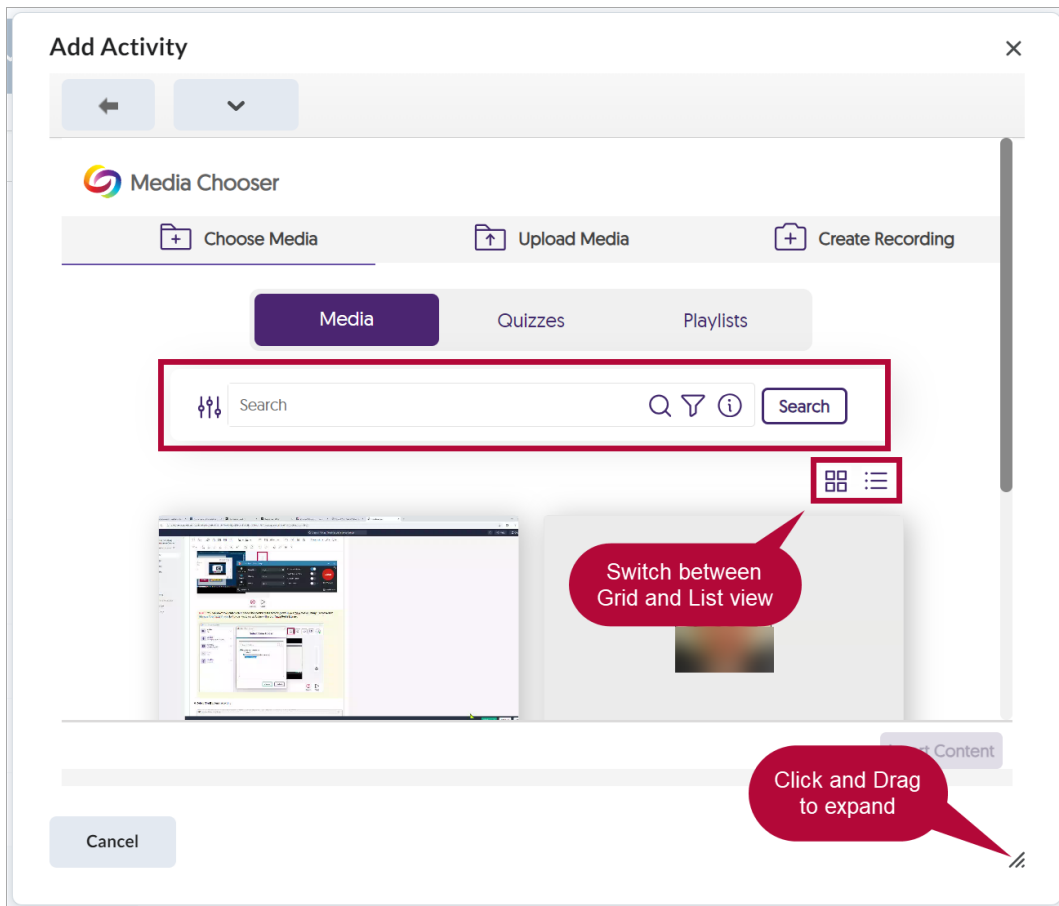


2. Select the module where you want to add your YuJa video. Then select **[Add Existing Activities]** followed by **[YuJa Media QuickLink]**.

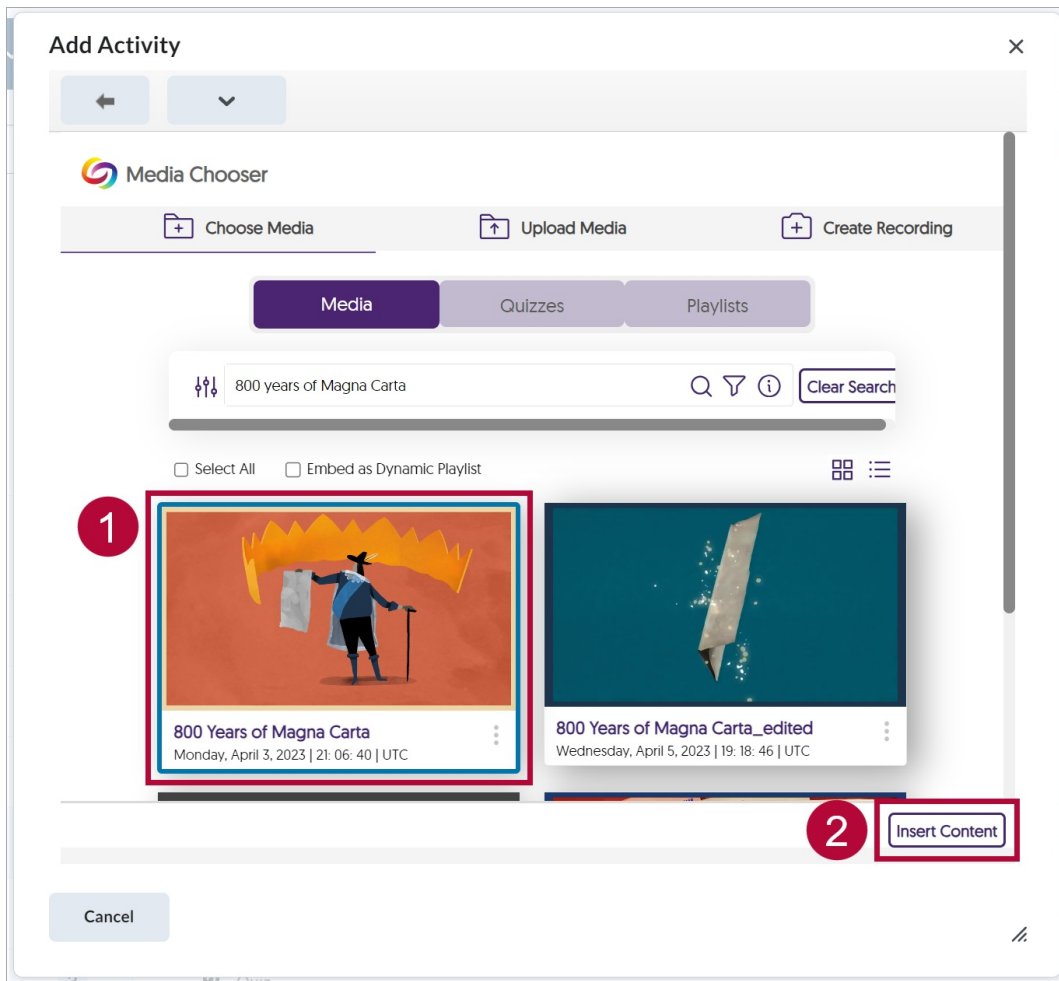


3. From the **Media** tab, search for the video you want to add by either scrolling or by using the **Search** field.

**NOTE:** Click and drag the corner icon to expand the **Media Chooser** window.



4. Select the video(s) you wish to add to your module, then select **[Insert Content]**.

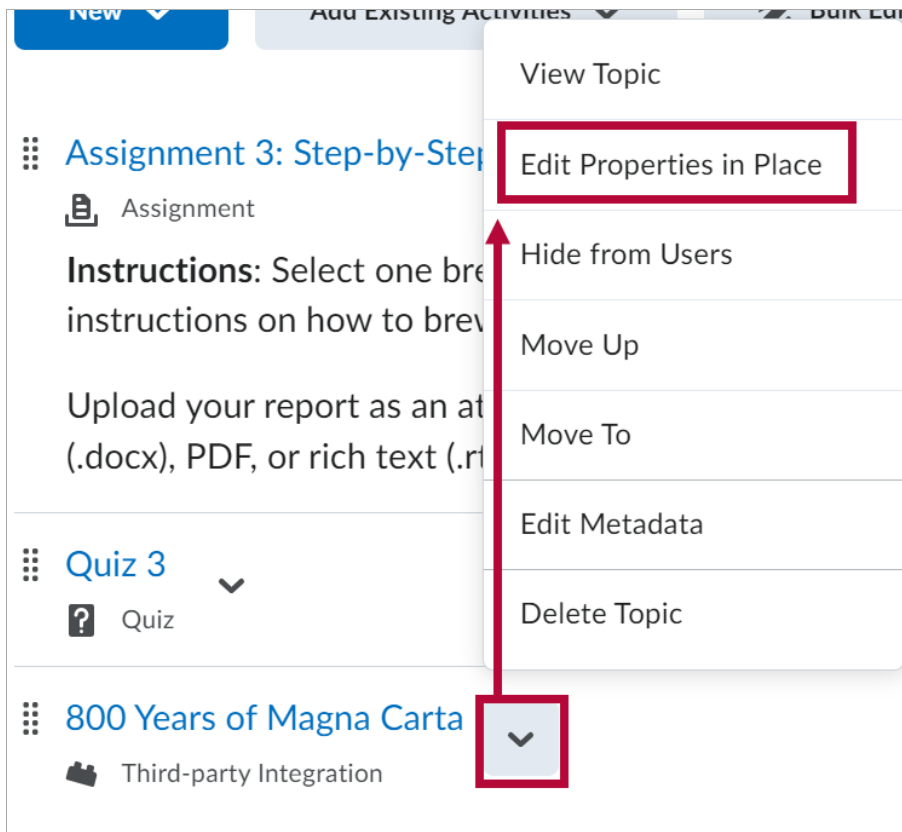


5. Upon inserting the video, the video title will show up in the module. Each video will be given a separate link.

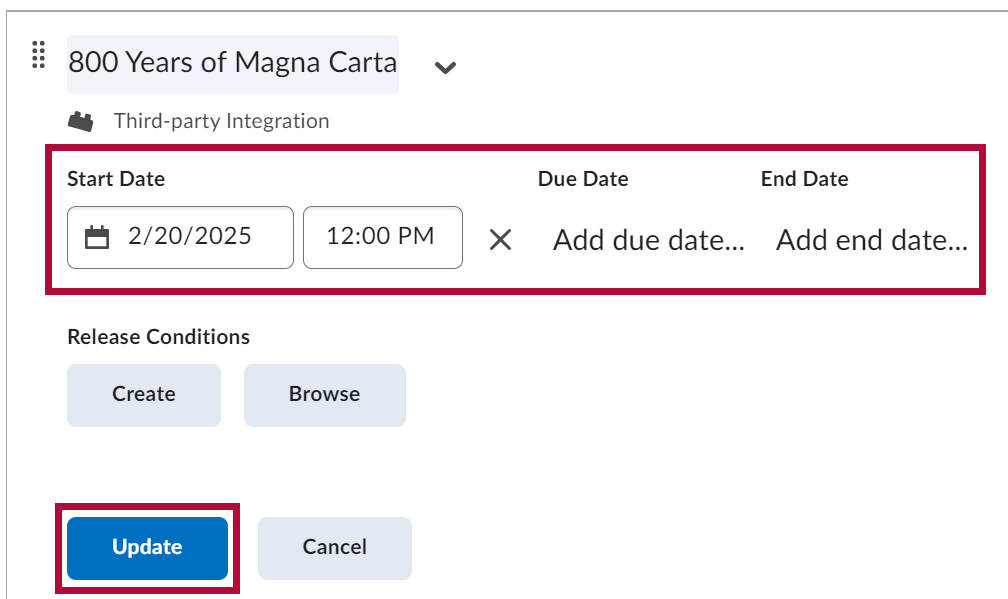

## Add Restriction Dates
