

Associate an Assessment with a Grade Item

In D2L, **assessments** include *Assignments*, *Quizzes*, and *Discussions*. In the example below, the assessment being linked is an Assignment.

NOTE: To link an assessment to a specific grade item in the Gradebook, you must do so by linking the assessment to the grade item directly. It is not possible to create this connection from within the Gradebook.

1. Head to the Assignment that you wish to link to a Grade Item. Click on the drop-down menu and select **[Edit Folder]**.
