

Use the Discover Tool to Self-Enroll

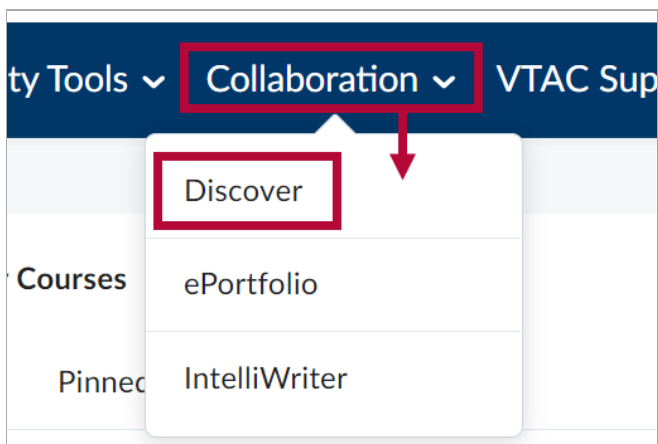

Discover is a tool which allows students and faculty to self-enroll in **Community Groups** in D2L. Once a Community Group is added to Discover, users can freely enroll and unenroll themselves in the Community Group, without needing to be added by a Group Manager (though a Group Manager is still able to [enroll users themselves \(https://vtac.lonestar.edu/help/add-users-to-community-group\)](https://vtac.lonestar.edu/help/add-users-to-community-group)). This can be useful for Community Groups in which a large number of students or faculty are expected to join, such as campus-wide initiatives. The instructions below illustrate how to enroll and unenroll yourself through Discover.

NOTE: If you wish to request a Community Group be added to Discover, please send an email to VTAC@lonestar.edu with the full name of the Community Group.

Use the Discover Tool to Enroll


1. From the **Navbar** on the **D2L Homepage**, select **[Collaboration]** followed by **[Discover]**.




2. A list of community groups available for self-enrollment will appear. Click on the community group you would like to enroll in. You can also use the **[Search]** bar if needed.

NOTE: Community Groups meant for students usually include the word **Student** in their name.

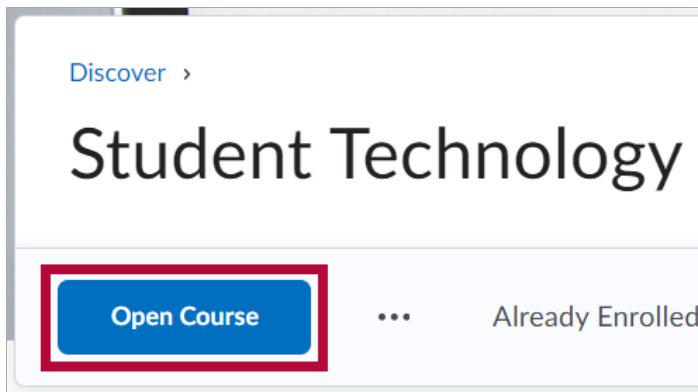
4. You will see a pop-up message confirming that you have enrolled. Click **[OK]**.

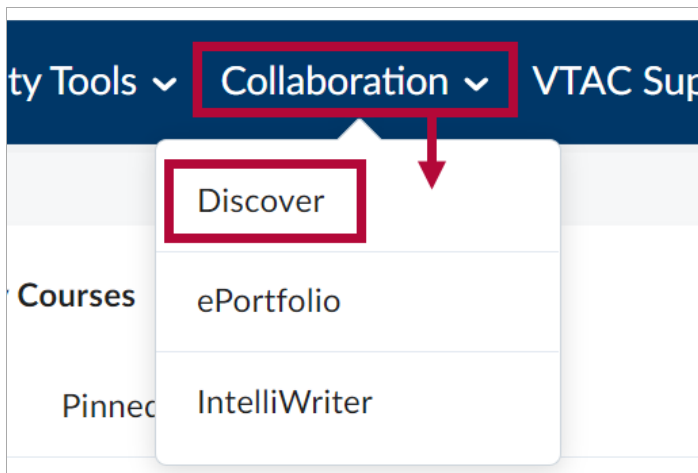

5. Click on the button that says **[Open Course]** to enter the course you've just enrolled in.

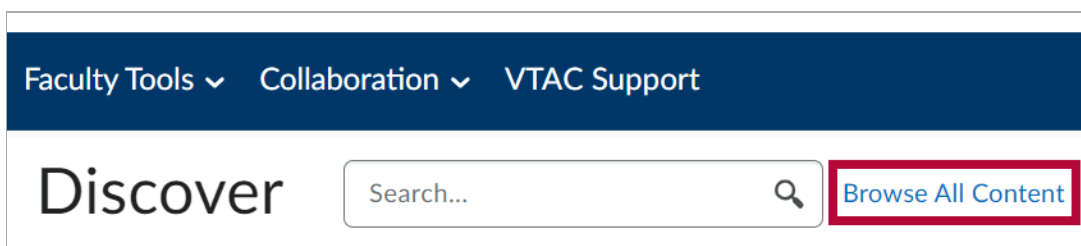


Use the Discover Tool to Un-enroll in Courses
