You can install the **Google Chrome** extension and **FireFox** extensions to use **OpenDyslexic** font in D2L.


## **Google Chrome**

To install the **Google Chrome OpenDyslexic** Extensions follow these steps:

3. Click on the [Puzzle Piece] at the upper right corner of the webpage, and click on [OpenDyslexic for Chrome].




4. Turn the application on and select the style.

To install the **Firefox OpenDyslexic Extensions** follow these steps:


