Create a Sandbox



A **Sandbox** is an area where you can work on designing your course that is not visible to students and allows you to use a **Test Student**. Sandboxes are meant for your individual course development; other people cannot be added to your sandbox.



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
- 1. Depending on where you are currently:
 - If you are already in the VTAC Support page, click on [VTAC Support], then [Create a Sandbox].



• If you are in your D2L course, click [VTAC Support] on the navbar.



2. In the Self-Service column under Course Design, click [Create a Sandbox].



3. Fill out the Sandbox Request form.



- Enter a short description (name) for your sandbox. The completed sandbox title will begin with "Sandbox: Your Name - [Short Description]" You should only enter a description that will appear after the words "Sandbox: Your Name."
- Enter a date for archiving. After this date, the system will archive the sandbox in the next round of automated archives.
- 4. **[Submit]** the Sandbox Request Form.
