You can now evaluate a student's response to a **Written Response** quiz question using a rubric. This will allow you to grade each student's response based on set criteria, and you can also provide additional feedback in the question **Feedback** field.

NOTE: Although you may add multiple rubrics to a written response question, only the *first rubric* is applied for grading.

To evaluate a written response question using an attached rubric, you must open your student's **Quiz Attempt** with the **New Quiz Evaluation Experience** for evaluation.
