


## Accessing the Pearson+ eBook From the Course Materials Dashboard in D2L

1. In your D2L course, select [Course Materials] from the Navbar. The Course Materials Dashboard will open in a new browser tab.



2. In the Course Materials Dashboard, click [My Courses] to display the Course Materials. Identify the Pearson+ eBook associated with your course—the eBook will be listed under the course materials for the current term. Click [Open] next to the eBook associated with your course to launch the digital textbook.


