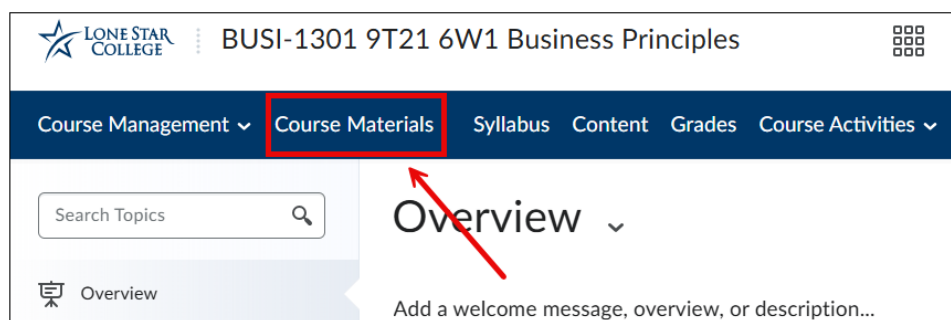

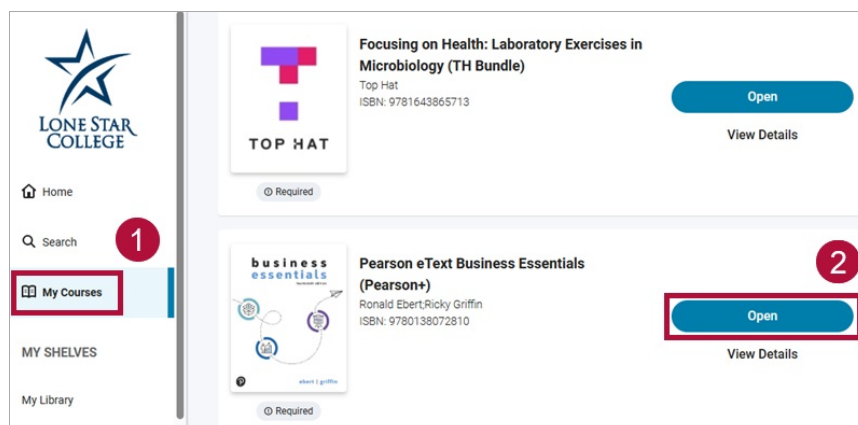
Accessing the Pearson+ eBook From the Course Materials Dashboard in D2L

1. In your D2L course, select **[Course Materials]** from the **Navbar**. The **Course Materials Dashboard** will open in a new browser tab.



2. In the **Course Materials Dashboard**, click **[My Courses]** to display the **Course Materials**. Identify the Pearson+ eBook associated with your course—the eBook will be listed under the course materials for the current term. Click **[Open]** next to the eBook associated with your course to launch the digital textbook.

NOTE: If prompted, sign in with your Pearson credentials to complete the access process.

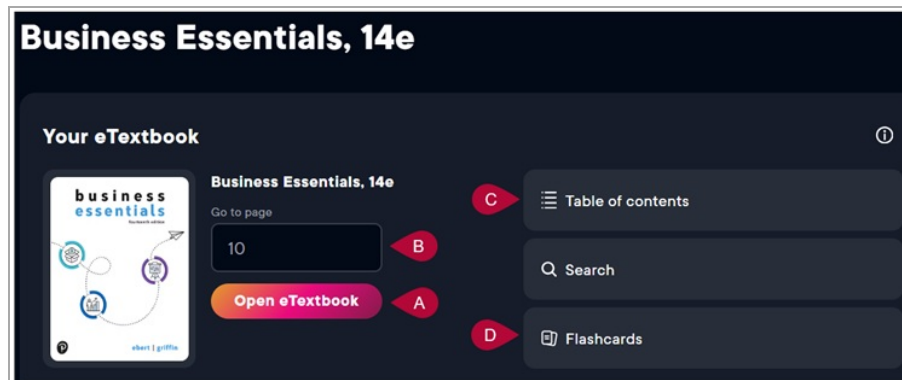


Using the Pearson+ Dashboard

- A. Click **[Open eTextbook]** or select the **[thumbnail]** on the left to open the eBook.
- B. To go to a specific page, enter a page number in the **[Go to page]** text field and click **[Open eTextbook]** to navigate directly to that page.
- C. Select **[Table of contents]** to browse and navigate through book chapters and sections.
- D. Select **[Flashcards]** to open interactive study tools, including flashcards and matching questions. For support with customizing or adding new flashcards, contact your Pearson representative.
