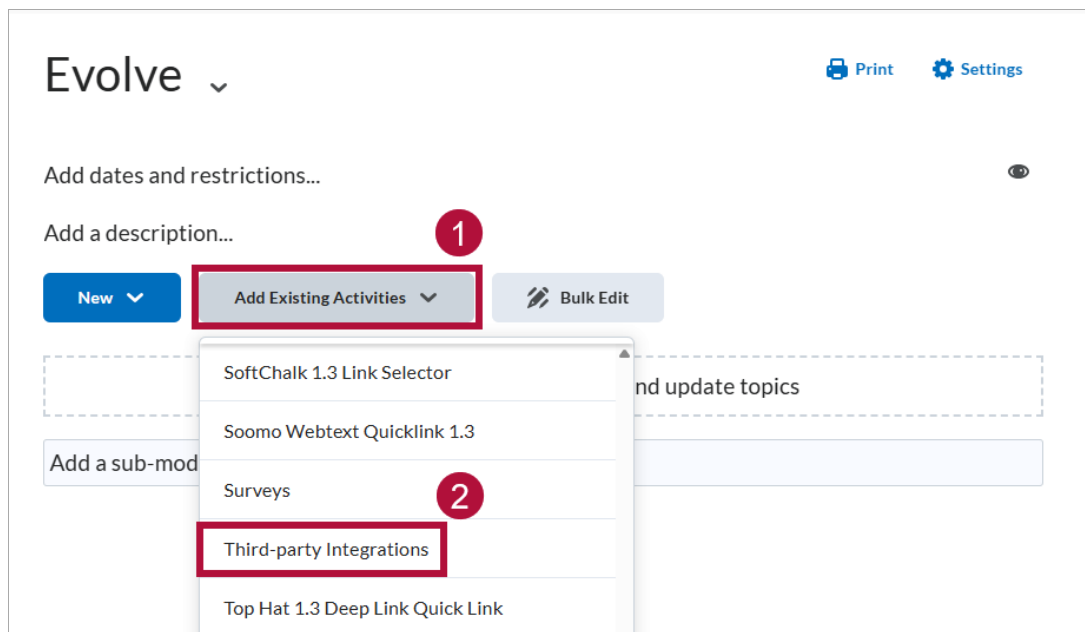

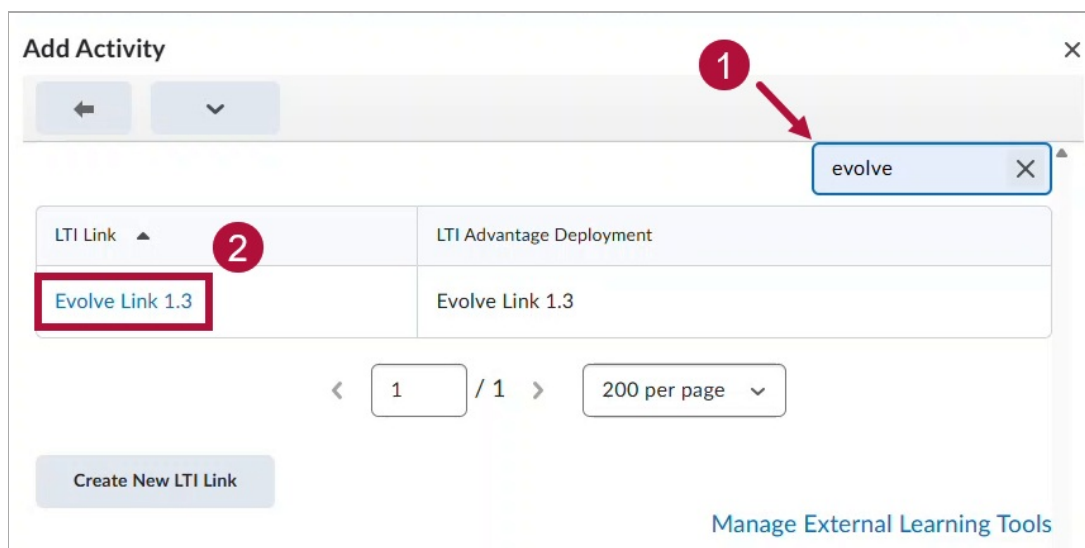
Adding Evolve 1.3 Sherpath Product to Your Course Content Module

NOTE: We recommend you work with your Evolve representative before attempting these steps.

1. Go to **[Content]** and select the module where you want to insert the Evolve 1.3 integration. For example, add a module and give it a name such as **Evolve 1.3**.
2. In your new module, select **[Add Existing Activities]**, then select **[Third-party Integrations]**.



3. In the **Search Box** located on the upper right, type in **evolve**, then select **[Evolve Link 1.3]** from the list. Once added, **[Evolve Link 1.3]** will appear in your current module.

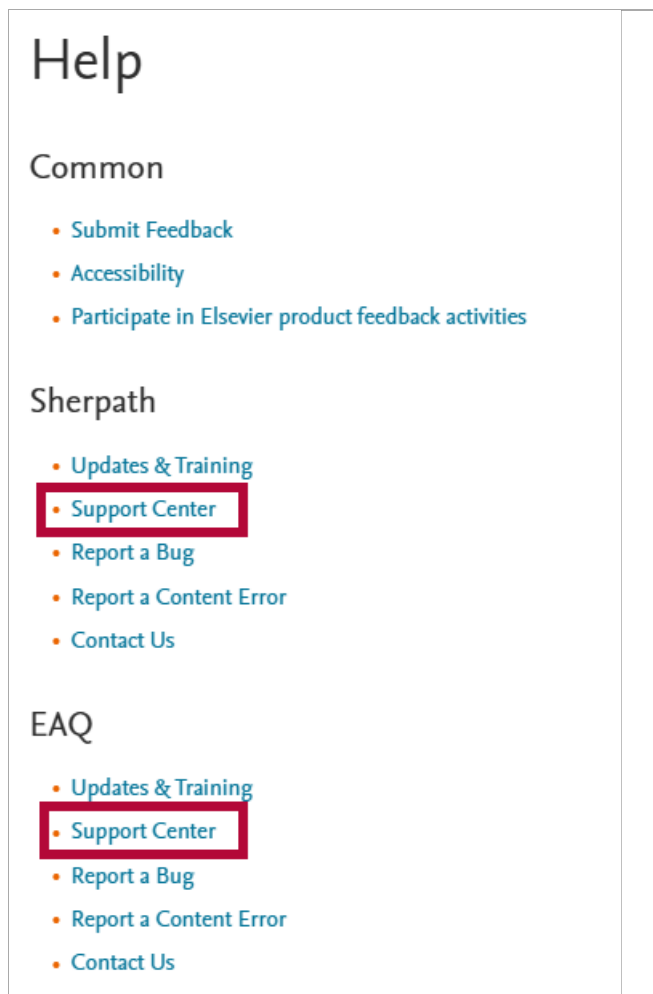
