2. Upon successfully submitting the registration form, you will receive email instructions to activate your account.
3. Once your account has been verified and activated, log in to Brightspace Community.
4. Select **Resources > D2L Academy** from the navigation menu.
5. Click on the **Accessibility Academy** tile.

1. Log into (or create) your [QM account associated with Lone Star College](#) (<https://vtac.lonestar.edu/help/a133>) to access MyQM.
2. Click on **Workshop - Register** on the left menu and choose **Register for Accessibility & Usability Resource Site**.
3. Click the **Register for Session** button.
4. Agree to both terms and click **Continue**.
5. Enter your LSC email address, which should be the email address you used to create your account.
6. The cost of training should be **\$0**. Click **Finalize Registration**.

After registering, it can take up to an hour to get access to the site. To access the site:

1. Log back into MyQM
2. Click on **Classroom** in the top menu.
3. Choose **Accessibility and Usability Resource Site** in the dashboard list.
